All machines must be manufactured before December 31st 1984 (inclusive) and have both an air-cooled engine and drum brakes (no water-cooled or disc braked machines). NO EXCEPTIONS

Clothing : As per UCMCC rules. The use of tear-off's is not permitted.

Licences : All Riders <u>must</u> show their current AMCA Classic Licence when Signing-on.

**Day Licences** [1] : Required by any entrant NOT in possession of a current AMCA Classic Licence.

Day Licences are not available at the meeting and must be requested with your entry. There

is a supplementary fee for each day licence required (see entry form).
